## OVERVIEW

Hand-woven textile panel with varied textured inserts, mounted and framed. A compact composition of rectangles and small geometric blocks—warm ochres, deep browns and subtle purples meet textured neutrals—punctuated by plush velvets, woven tapestries and patterned trims. The work is set against a wide matte black passepartout and a simple black wood frame. Handmade production: each piece is developed from sketch to vertical loom and requires many hours of careful weaving, cutting and hand finishing.

## DESCRIPTION

A tactile study in contrast and material juxtaposition. The surface is a close-knit collage of handwoven strips, small panels and inserts where dense warp and weft meet a variety of textured elements—short-pile velvets, coarse weaves, jacquards and decorative ribbons. These differing surfaces introduce varied sheens and reliefs that counterpoint one another; light travels uniquely across plush, matte and structured patches, producing subtle shadows and a layered sense of depth. Mounted visibly on a broad matte black passe-partout and housed in a minimal black-stained wood frame, the piece reads as a stitched relief map or miniature architectural façade. The pared-back framing foregrounds materiality: irregular stitched joins, slight colour variations, selvedge details and hand-finished edges all attest to manual making. Produced with Sardinian and locally sourced natural fibres and traditional techniques adapted for a contemporary vocabulary, every work is one-of-a-kind. Ideal as an intimate focal accent in a study, hallway or gallery wall where texture and craft are central.

Hand weaving on a vertical loom with layered warp and weft, inserts, and mixed textured elements.

### Production

Handmade production time: each piece is developed in stages—from sketch to vertical loom to assembly—and requires many hours of weaving, appliqué and finishing.

- Avoid prolonged direct sunlight, extreme heat and high humidity to preserve fibres and colours.
- For stains, consult a professional textile conservator; spot cleaning only is recommended.

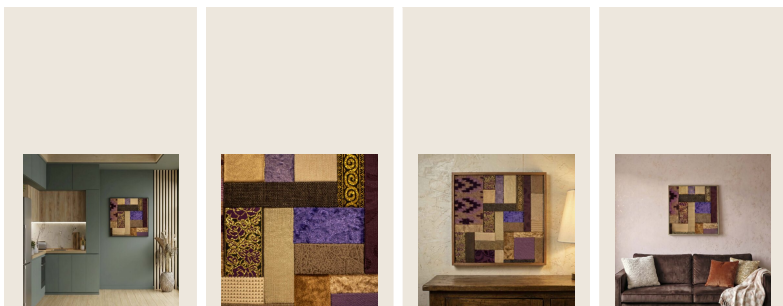
